Applications are invited for a Term Adjunct to teach 33.3% of a three-credit load of an independent study course entitled

HPE 898: Project: Health Professions Education

Course Level: Graduate

Location: onQ

Anticipated Enrolment: 17

Period of Appointment: January 1 – August 31, 2024

The Master of Health Professions Education is a program in which every course is team-taught by a health professional and an educationalist PhD.

Course Description:

The focus of this capstone course is on the scholarship of integration, implementation, and application. The course will be guided by a faculty member at Queen's University and or a mentor based in practice. Learners will identify their project by the end of the first year so that if ethical and administrative approvals are required there will be plenty of time to complete the project by the end of the program.

Course Deliverables:

- April 30 - Proposal for Capstone Assignment
- May 31 - Teaching Perspectives Inventory (TPI) Analysis
- June 30 - Portfolio of Self-Selected Assignments
- July 31 - Teaching Dossier
- August 15 - Three-Minute Presentation of Capstone Assignment
- August 31 - Capstone Assignment

Qualifications for the Appointment:

A doctorate in education or relevant field with at least two years of post-doctoral experience relevant to the field of instruction.

As this course is being offered in an online format, successful candidates will also:

- Have regular access to high-speed internet and a computer that meets current specifications
- Be willing to team-teach
- Take an active role in delivering the course through onQ
- Communicate regularly with students
- Be open to learning how to use new technologies in order to be effective in the virtual environment
- Be willing to provide students with timely and constructive feedback on onQ
- Be comfortable with working in a partnership in the delivery of the course

Individuals interested in applying for this term adjunct teaching position should submit an application by December 1, 2023. The application shall include:

- A cover letter
- A complete and current curriculum vitae (CV)
- The names of two referees who may be contacted
- Any other materials the applicant wishes to submit (such as a teaching dossier)
